



NOTICE OF CHANGE

EDMONTON CITY AREA TRAFFIC FREQUENCY EDMONTON, ALBERTA

NAV CANADA has completed an aeronautical study that reviewed the structure of the airspace surrounding the city of Edmonton. The study was prompted by the closure of the Edmonton City Centre Airport. In addition to airspace changes that were implemented on 27 May 2014 the study recommended the following:

- Establish an air traffic frequency for pilot-to-pilot communication outside the TCA and CZs to be used in a defined area over the city of Edmonton. (Note: On an interim basis the previous Edmonton City Centre tower frequency 119.1 was used); and
- On the reverse side of the Edmonton VTA display a planning chart to depict special procedures and areas of particular interest or complexity.

Publication Changes:

- The Edmonton City Area Traffic Frequency will be changed from 119.1 to 123.2 MHz;
- The Canada Flight Supplement (CFS) Planning Section C - Alberta – will include a sketch of the 123.2 Common Frequency Area (**see below**); and
- The Edmonton VTA (AIR1906, Edition 21) available May 6 will display on the reverse side a Planning Chart with special procedures and areas of particular interest or complexity including the area designated for the new Edmonton City ATF 123.2.

These changes will take effect **5 March 2015 at 0901 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC)**
